#### Please check areas of interest

- ☐ **Trapping:** Trappers are needed to travel to cat colonies, set humane traps, and transport trapped cats to our clinic to await surgery. Trapping is done on Saturday evenings. A vehicle is required.
- ☐ **Transporting:** Volunteers with good-sized vehicles are needed to return cats to their colonies on the Monday following spay/neuter clinics.
- ☐ **Veterinary technicians and clinic assistants:** Volunteers are needed at our monthly clinics (Sundays) to assist our veterinarians with induction, prep, anesthesia, and recovery of cats. Volunteers are also needed for checking in cats, filling out medical records, and cleaning and moving traps. Vet tech experience is helpful but not required.
- ☐ **Cleaning:** We need volunteers to clean the clinic Monday mornings and clean traps Monday afternoons.
